

Acts 1 Study Guide for a Men's Group

1. Acts 1:1-8 — Preparation and Promise of Power

-Focus Areas:

- Jesus reminds the apostles of their mission and promises the Holy Spirit's power (Acts 1:4-5, 8).
- The call to be His witnesses "in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8).
- The importance of waiting and being spiritually prepared (Acts 1:4, 14).

-Men's Group Reflection:

- How are you preparing yourself to be a bold witness for Christ in your daily life and community?
- Are you relying on your own strength, or are you depending on the Holy Spirit's power?
- What does "waiting on God" look like for you in times of uncertainty or challenge?

2. Acts 1:9-11 — The Ascension and the Call to Look Upward

-Focus Areas:

- Jesus ascends to heaven, affirming His authority and ongoing work (Acts 1:9-11).
- The promise that He will return "in the same way" (Acts 1:11).
- The disciples are left looking upward—expecting God's continued movement.

-Men's Group Reflection:

- How does the reality of Jesus' ascension and return impact your motivation as a Christian man?
- What does it mean to keep your eyes "on the prize" and live with eternal perspective?
- How can you encourage others to stay focused on Christ's return amid everyday distractions?

3. Acts 1:12-26 — Unity in Mission and Leadership

-Focus Areas:

- The apostles return to Jerusalem and devote themselves to prayer and unity (Acts 1:12-14).
- They select Matthias to replace Judas, showing the importance of godly leadership and responsibility (Acts 1:15-26).

-Men's Group Reflection:

- How are you contributing to unity and prayer in your family, church, or men's group?
- What qualities should a leader in your life and community embody, based on this example?
- Are you ready to step into leadership roles and responsibilities that God may be calling you to?

Practical Applications for Men's Lives:

-Preparation: Encourage men to set aside intentional time for prayer and waiting on God's guidance.

-Witness: Challenge the group to identify specific ways they can witness boldly in their spheres of influence this week.

-Leadership: Discuss ways to cultivate godly leadership qualities—integrity, faithfulness, courage—and encourage men to support one another in growing these.

-Unity: Promote accountability and prayer partnerships within the group to strengthen spiritual brotherhood.
