- Stephen falsely accused of blasphemy (Act 6:8-15).

-Men's Group Reflection:

- Are you willing to serve where God has placed you, even if it's behind the scenes or not glamorous?
- What qualities of Stephen—faith, wisdom, Spirit-filled character—do you want to cultivate?
- How can the group support one another in serving with humility? And in standing strong in the face of opposition intent on our destruction?

Acts 7: Courage to Stand and Witness

-Focus Areas:

- Stephen's powerful defense before the council, recounting Israel's history (Acts 7:1-53).
- Stephen boldly confronts the leaders about their rejection of God's messengers (Acts 7:54-60).
- Stephen becomes the first Christian martyr, praying for his persecutors (Acts 7:59-60).

-Men's Group Reflection:

- What does Stephen's courage teach you about standing firm in your faith when faced with opposition?
- How can you develop a heart that prays for your enemies and those who oppose you?
- Are you ready to be a bold witness, even if it means personal cost?

Practical Applications for Men's Lives:

- **-Integrity Challenge:** Encourage men to examine areas where God may be calling them to greater honesty and accountability.
- -Service Commitment: Discuss ways each man can serve their family, church, or community with faithfulness and humility.
- -Courage Builders: Share stories or testimonies about standing firm under pressure and pray for boldness.
- -Prayer Focus: Follow Stephen's example in praying for those who oppose or challenge your faith.
